

CKCSCC Versatility Awards - Canadian Kennel Club (CKC) Events

To showcase that Cavalier King Charles Spaniels are versatile, trainable and healthy dogs who can attain success in a number of varied CKC events, the CKCSCC Board of Directors has approved two levels of Versatility Awards. The awards would be based on lifetime achievements of dogs across multiple event categories, based on a points system.

Rules for Eligibility for awards – General:

- Awards are to be considered in response to application by club members for dogs living at the time of application. Dogs eligible for the awards must be owned or co-owned by club members
- Categories of CKC Conformation, Obedience, Rally Obedience, Agility and Tracking will be considered, with only the highest title achieved in each category counting toward points. The categories are subject to revision based on amendments to events offered by the CKC. The categories may also be revised from time to time by the Board of Directors.
- Each dog would be eligible for only one award per level (Versatility or Versatility Excellent), regardless of the combination of category points
- The Performance Director will receive and examine the applications and prepare the certificates.

Requirements for Versatility Award

At least 7 points must be accumulated across 3 different categories.

Requirements for Versatility Excellent Award

At least 12 points must be accumulated across 4 different categories.

Weighting of Points

Example:

A dog who had earned the following titles would be eligible for the Versatility Award:

Ch 3 points
 TD 2 points
AgIS 3 points
 8 points
